You will be responsible for providing safe and reliable transport for our students to and from school and other approved locations. The role is vital in helping our learners access education and supporting their wellbeing through safe daily journeys.

Job Description

Main Purpose of the Role

To provide a safe, reliable and professional transport service for learners attending the Alternative Provision, ensuring that students are transported securely to and from educational settings, alternative venues, work placements and educational visits. The post holder will contribute to the school's safeguarding culture by promoting pupil welfare, maintaining high standards of health and safety, and supporting vulnerable children and young people, many of whom may present with social, emotional and mental health needs (SEMH), behavioural challenges or additional vulnerabilities.

Key Responsibilities

Safeguarding and Student Welfare

- Safeguard and promote the welfare of all children and young people in line with Keeping Children Safe in Education (KCSIE) and the school's safeguarding policies.
- Maintain professional vigilance and report any safeguarding concerns immediately to the Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) or Deputy DSL.
- Support safe transitions to and from school, recognising that transport arrangements may present safeguarding risks.
- Build positive, professional relationships with students while maintaining appropriate boundaries at all times.
- Monitor student wellbeing during journeys and report concerns regarding attendance, welfare, behaviour or wellbeing.
- Follow school procedures for managing missing students, late collections, incidents or emergencies.

Transport and Student Supervision

- Transport students safely, courteously and efficiently between home, school and other approved locations.
- Ensure all students travel safely using seatbelts and follow transport expectations.
- Promote positive behaviour during journeys and de-escalate situations calmly and professionally in accordance with school behaviour policies.
- Maintain appropriate supervision of students while entering, travelling in and exiting the vehicle.
- Ensure accurate registers and records are maintained for pupils transported.
- Liaise effectively with parents/carers, school staff and external agencies where required.

Job Description

Health and Safety

- Conduct daily vehicle safety inspections and complete required documentation before and after journeys.
- Ensure the vehicle remains roadworthy, clean, secure and appropriately fuelled.
- Report defects, maintenance issues, accidents, incidents or concerns promptly.
- Comply with all road traffic legislation, health and safety requirements and school policies.
- Undertake risk assessments and follow agreed control measures for transport activities.
- Support safe evacuation procedures and respond appropriately during emergencies.
- Follow manual handling, lone working and educational visit procedures where applicable.

Compliance and Professional Responsibilities

- Hold and maintain the appropriate driving licence, qualifications and permits required for minibus operation.
- Attend mandatory safeguarding, health and safety, first aid and behaviour management training.
- Maintain accurate records relating to vehicle checks, incidents, accidents and transport logs.
- Act as a positive representative of the school within the community.
- Promote equality, diversity and inclusion, treating all pupils with dignity and respect.
- Undertake any other duties commensurate with the grade and responsibility of the post.
